

## **NAG ONE: Curriculum Policy**

### Statement of Intent

The Royal Oak Primary School Board of Trustees will ensure that:

- 1) the New Zealand curriculum is delivered through high quality, equitable, student centred teaching and learning programmes that provide opportunities for success in the 21<sup>st</sup> century;
- 2) priority is given to personalised learning in literacy, numeracy and the “Key Competencies”;
- 3) comprehensive assessment practices are integral to teaching and learning and will provide sufficient analysis to identify children’s current needs, and groups of children requiring intervention and/or enrichment;
- 4) through in-depth reporting of achievement, recommendations are implemented to enhance programmes that meet the specific needs and special character of the children at Royal Oak Primary School; and
- 5) meaningful consultation with key stakeholders, including the Maori community, takes place on a regular basis to improve children’s achievement.
