Science Award Programme



The Science Award is a programme for Year 4, 5 and 6 students organised by Whaea Robyn in the Taiao Room. She has been to each Oaks classroom and talked to the students about this programme and has handed out notes and permission slips to students that are interested in doing it. If your child was away last week or has since decided they want to do this programme, it is not too late to join. It involves doing eight science projects from a selection of about 30, at home, from a card from the Science Award Trust that Whaea Robyn orders. The science projects are done at home, and Whaea Robyn marks them and gives feedback. If your child achieves all eight before the end of Term 3, they get a certificate for Year 4 and a badge and certificate for Year 5 and 6.
